



UPDATED NOTICE REGARDING TEMPORARY CLOSURE - Monday, April 13, 2020

Dear Patients and Families:

We truly miss seeing you and look forward to seeing you when we can safely resume operations! We continue to closely monitor the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and the guidance provided by national, state and local public health and safety authorities.

Our target date for re-opening on Thursday, April 23, 2020 is no longer viable due to continuing health and safety concerns in our local area and state; the American Dental Association (ADA) recommends that dental offices continue to postpone all elective procedures and adhere to local and state government mandates. We plan to update you regarding a new target date for re-opening once more definitive information is available regarding when it is safe to do so. Our doctors will continue to be available to triage dental emergencies that may arise during our temporary closure.
